# Kimberley and Elkford Processes

- No road map = different approaches
- Worked together to share information, data, participate in events
- Kimberley
  - Local coordinator
  - Local steering committee
  - Public engagement and volunteer input every step
  - Focus was broad and participatory
  - Visualization used to communicate with community
- Elkford
  - Team of three consultants coordinated with OCP consultants
  - Direct linkages with OCP process and timeline
  - Shared resources for events and coordination
  - Joint community advisory committee for OCP/climate change
  - Focus on capacity building of district staff and council
  - Focus on 3 key impact areas
