

Board and Director Orientation and Education

1 Orientation

- 1.1 Each new Director participates in an orientation process, which includes:
- A review of the responsibilities of the Board, its committees and directors; and
 - A review of the mandate, operations, strategic priorities, and key policies of CBT.

2 Continuing Education

- 2.1 The Executive Committee is responsible for identifying the educational and training needs of the Board and each individual Director. At the same time, individual Directors have a responsibility to advise the Board Chair if they consider that they personally or the Board as a whole would benefit from specific skills training or education respecting matters falling within the responsibility of the Board or relating to the business and operations of CBT.
- 2.2 Subject to the prior approval of the Chair, each Director may elect to attend educational seminars that will improve his or her ability to govern the organization.
- 2.3 The Board of Directors may also choose to participate in educational seminars as a group.
